THE HOME IS DIVIDED INTO 3 SECTIONS

- Snehasadan** is a handicapped childrens residential school. There are 51 Girls and 74 Boys. A total of 125 physically disabled and Cerebral Palsy children are rehabilitated in this section. Along with education they are treated for their deformity and handicaps by Physiotherapy, Occupational therapy and corrective surgeries. Every child get one hour of therapy.

They should keep emergency numbers in the mobile. If someone harasses you, hit them in their vital part, it will give time to escape and inform to police and the family.

2nd session was on, Safety measures in fire breakouts. Due to short circuit of electricity, leakage of gas, we need not get panic, but use simple safety measures. Use wet cloth, fire extinguishers and inform the fire brigade.

3rd session was on, Career guidance and Interviews, on how to crack an interview practical session was demonstrated.

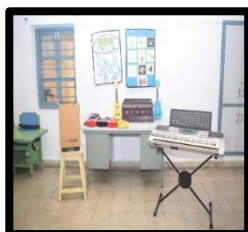


1. Bilateral Hamstring Release.

❖ MAKING HERBAL HOLI COLOURS:



Colours play a special role in the festival of Holi. Traditionally, the bright flowers of spring were used to make Holi colours, however, with time, the natural colours came to be replaced with chemically processed and synthetic colours. Using these colours can cause skin allergies, eye



irritation etc. Artificial colours can also be harmful to the environment as they take long time to decompose. The presence of harmful chemicals like oxides, glass particles and metal substances in the Holi colours makes it dangerous for human skin. Therefore, the Students of Home for Aged and Handicapped made organic Holi colours which were crafted from chemical free natural ingredients such as flower petals, beetroot, neem leaves, turmeric etc. The production and



promotion of environment-friendly Holi was prepared by using the different parts of the plants, green colour was made from ground neem leaves and spinach, yellow and red from turmeric, red colour was made from beetroot, orange colour from marigold flower petals. A total of 100 kg organic colours were made by the students of our institution, out of which 25kg was



purchased by Indian Oil Co. Ltd., 30kg was purchased by the staff and students of Providence Girls School and the remaining product was purchased by the local people.

❖ **SUCCESS STORY: MRS. Janabai Prakash Pawar**



Janabai was born on 12-05-1981 at Navargo, 30 KM from Nagpur. Born normal child, at the age of 1 year 6 months she got fever and affected with Polio. Her mother was taking her for Physiotherapy and she remained in our home for aged for treatment and exercise, with physical challenge she couldn't walk like normal person. Her parents were farmers. Jana grew up in the village with other siblings. And completed her schooling up to class 7th in the village. High School study she completed in Nagpur and finished her skill training at our Preranalya sheltered workshop. In tailoring she was passionate, earning her lively hood by stitching clothes. The institution started tailoring work shop in the year 2011 to support and provide the place to work for the handicapped persons who had who had no job. Janabai started to work in workshop and was supervising cutting clothes. She was doing efficiently. On 10th January 2014, her son Shivam was born. She was in her in-law's



place at Ahmednagar and came to Nagpur in 2021 for the sake of her son's education. Her husband Prakash died in an accident on 15-08-2021. Janabai took courage to raise her son. She was living with the earnings of stitching clothes. She got a job in the boutique, called Khub Surat. She works from 12 noon to 9 p.m in the shop. Her son Shivam studying at Pandit Bachrao school in class Vth. Shivam is good at studies and sports and helps mother in the house hold work. Recently Janabai got wheel chair to supply zamato orders. She starts her day at 7 A.M and works up to 11 Am as a zamato food supplier and gets extra earnings.

She is confident and faces life single handedly. She is grateful to the management for the education she received from institution and for all the support she found in her adverse times. According to her, she got courage and motivation from sisters to face life as a single mother.
